Do I Need a Pass?

If you leave your car unattended while recreating at Red Rock fee sites, display a valid pass or decal on your dashboard.

Where can I get a Valid Pass?

Red Rock Passes: Daily and Weekly Passes are available from fee machines at all fee sites (debit and credit cards only). Annual Passes are available at the Red Rock Ranger Station. All passes are also available at the Chamber of Commerce and Oak Creek Visitor Center.


